---

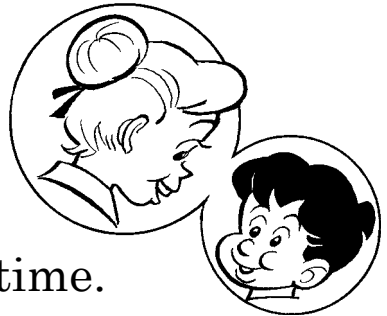
This girl can dance.

---

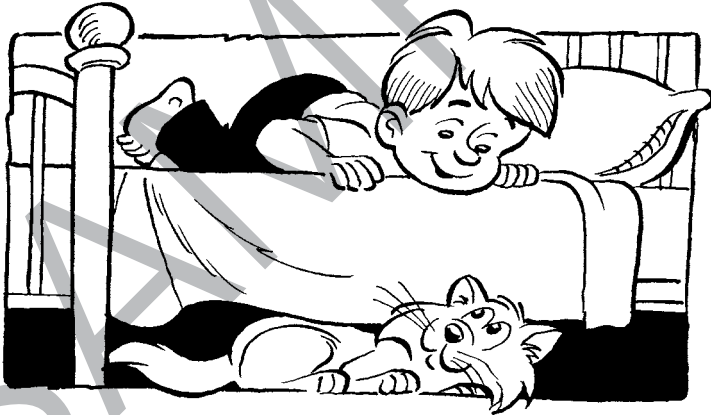
This cat is not nice to birds.

---

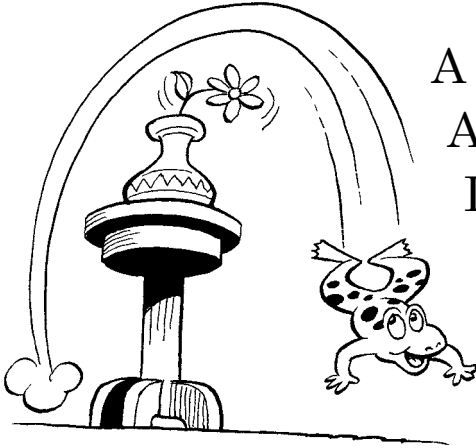
Ben is on the bed.

Donna is six.

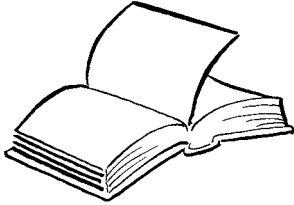
Anna is five.

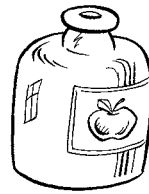

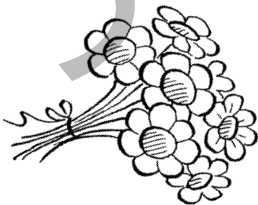

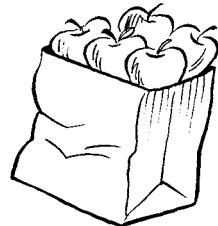

Mother will give

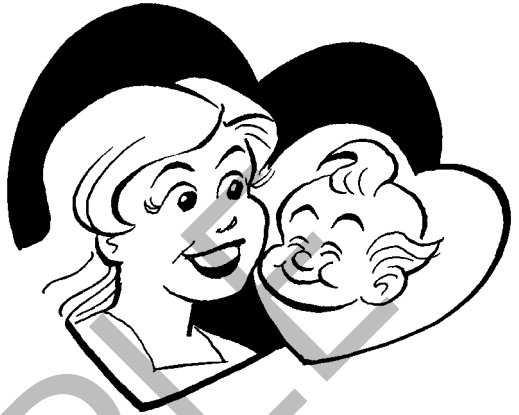
Jake some toys.
