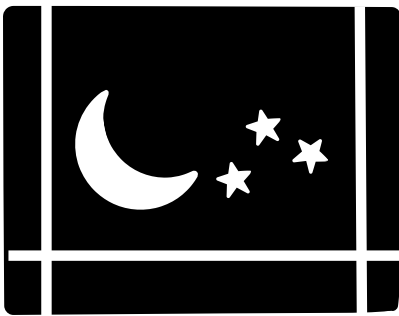
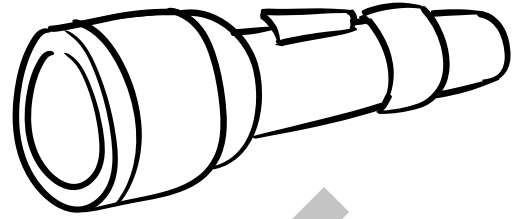
The sun gives light.

A fire-fly gives light.



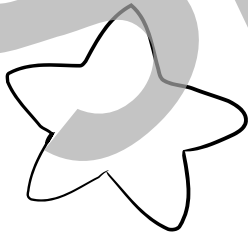
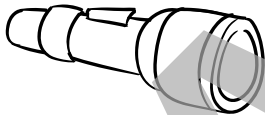
When we have no light, it is dark.

The earth is dark at night.

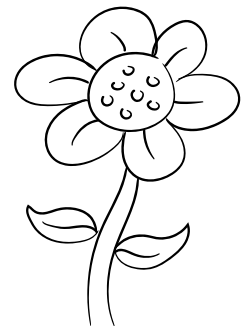
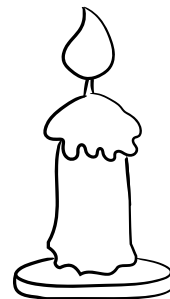
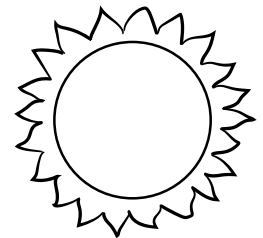
We use lights in our houses at night.

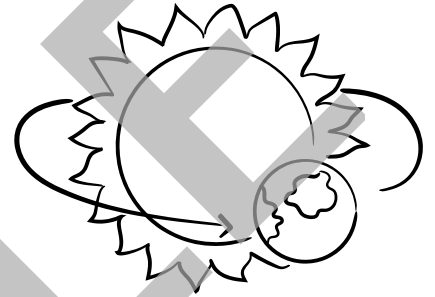

This helps to give us times.

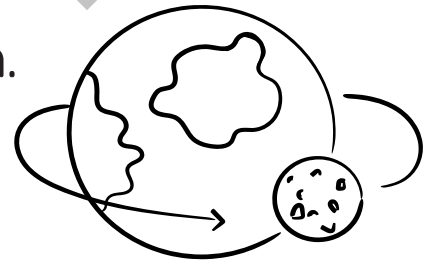
## A year

It takes one **year**.



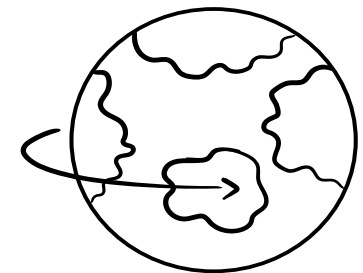
## A month

It takes one **month**.



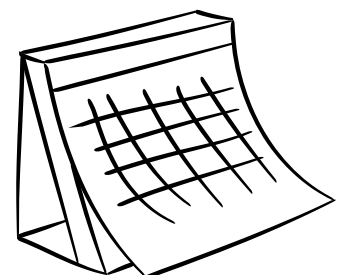
## A day

It takes one **day**.



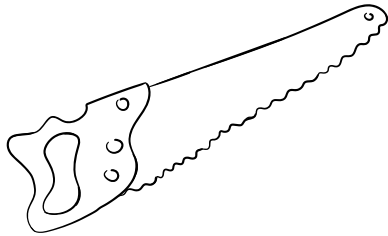
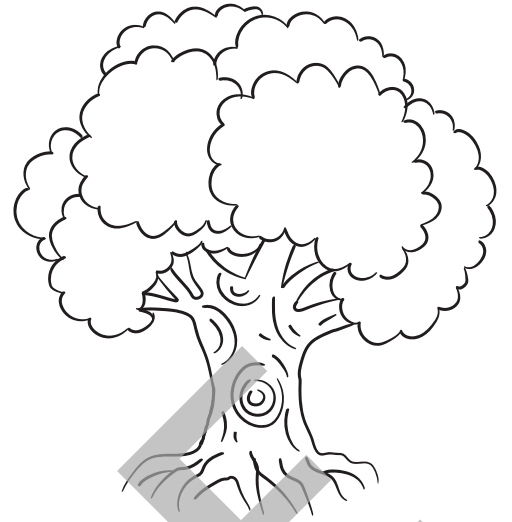
## A week

This is called a **week-end**.

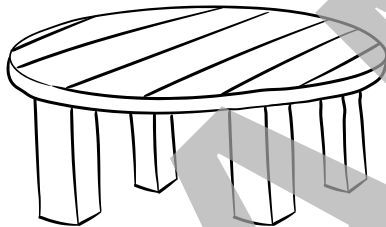


# 8 Trees

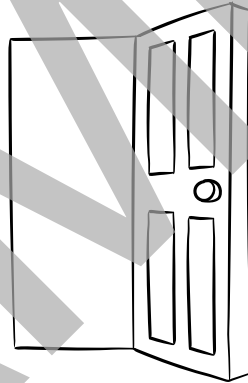
We can get wood from a tree.



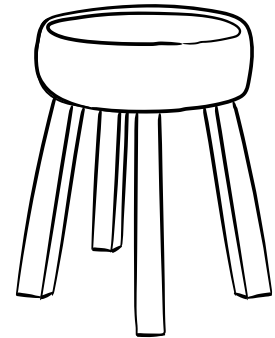
We can cut the wood with a saw or an axe.

**Glass** is made from sand.

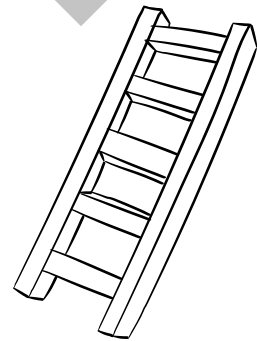
**Metal** is dug from the ground.

A dog can lead a blind person.

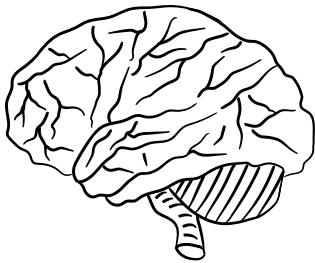


# Inside the body

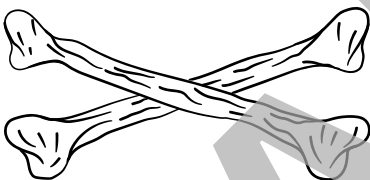
There are **organs** inside the body.  
They do jobs to help us live and work.



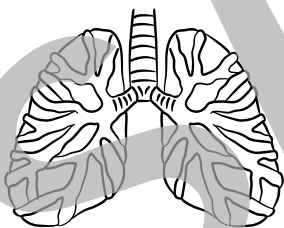
The **heart** pumps the blood ('blud').
